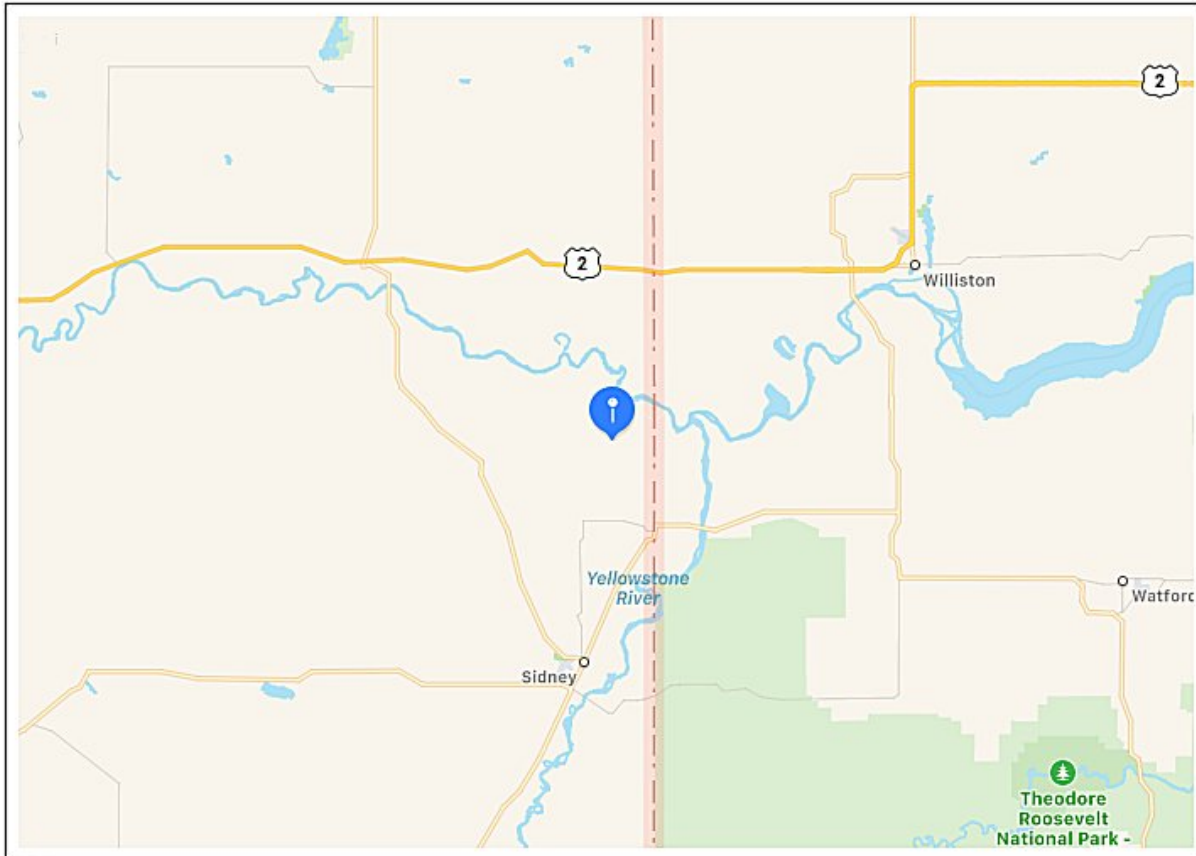


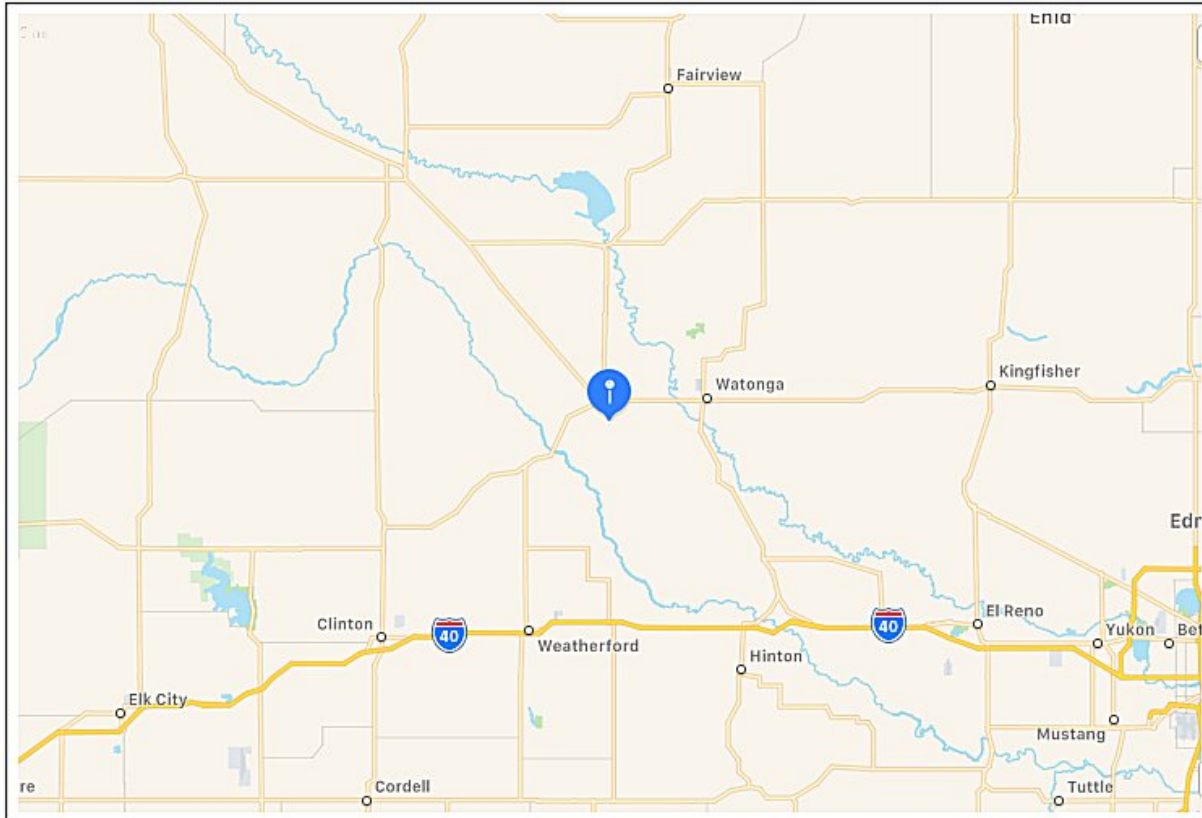
Best of Activity Highlights: Week of January 28



WESTERN

[Three Extended-reach Bakken Wells Announced In Roosevelt County, Mont.](#)

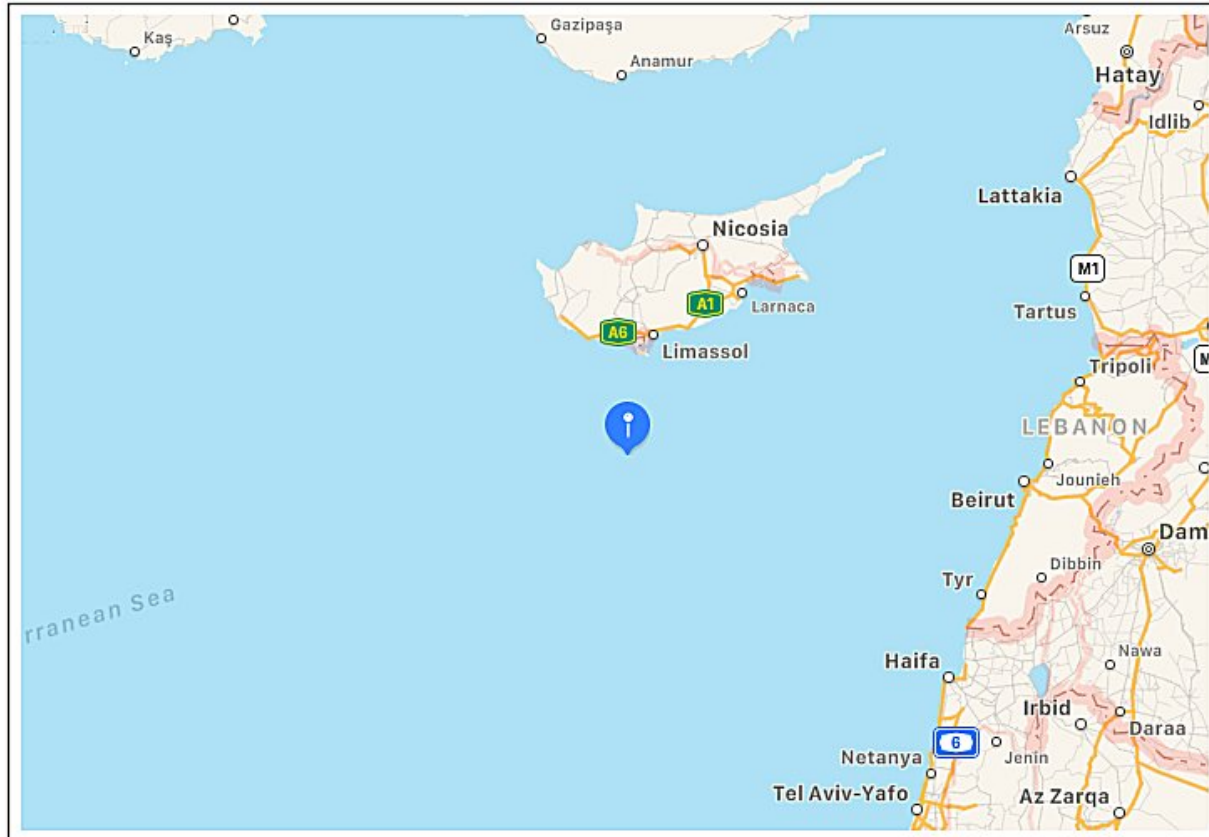
Kraken Operating LLC has completed three extended-reach horizontal Bakken producers from a drillpad in Section 33-26n-59e of Richland County, Mont. The #5-8-1H Fletch flowed 1.21 Mbbl of oil, with 716 Mcf of gas and 2.244 Mbbl of water per day. Production is from a Bakken lateral drilled southwestward to 20,895 ft, 10,444 ft true vertical, and it bottomed in Section 8-25n-59e. It was fractured in an undisclosed number of stages between 10,771 and 20,844 ft and tested on an unreported choke size with a flowing tubing pressure of 1,550 psi. The #32-31-1H Elroy flowed 1.007 Mbbl of oil, 614 Mcf of gas and 2.259 Mbbl of water daily from a fractured interval at 10,716-20,751 ft. It bottomed to the west in Section 31-26n-59e. The #4-9-2H Eagle flowed 1.36 Mbbl of oil, 778 Mcf of gas and 2.315 Mbbl of water per day from a fractured horizontal interval at 10,703-20,718 ft. It bottomed to the south in Section 9-25n-59e. Kraken is based in Houston.

[Meramec Completion Flows 9.6 MMcf Of Gas, 2.004 Mbbl Of Condensate Per Day](#)

A **Continental Resources Inc.** Meramec well flowed 9.6 MMcf of gas, 2.004 Mbbl of condensate and 1.622 Mbbl of water per day. The Stack play well, #1-33XH Lugene, is in Section 33-16n-13w of Blaine County, Okla. It was tested on a 34/64-in. choke producing from an acidized and fractured interval at 11,804-16,129 ft. The Anadarko Basin venture was horizontally drilled northward to 16,304 ft with a true vertical depth of 11,418 ft.

[ExxonMobil Plans To Resume Offshore Cyprus Testing In Block 10](#)

ExxonMobil Corp. and Qatar Petroleum are expecting to receive permission from the government of Cyprus to return to its exploration operation in Block 10, despite warnings from Turkey that such activity infringes on the rights of the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus. According to the Cypriot newspaper, *Phileleftheros*, the partners plan to drill its initial exploration well on the block in 2018 at a site far from the area in dispute between the Cypriot factions. The first well, #1-Delphini, will be followed by wells at the Antheia and Glafkos prospects.
